

Halloween Bingo

To make:

You will find the Halloween Bingo games boards on pages 2-5. Print out two copies of each and put one set aside. Cut the other set apart to form the “calling cards”.

To play:

Each player takes a bingo game board. Shuffle the calling cards and place face down in the centre of the table. Turn over the calling cards one by one and look to see if you have the same picture on your board. Be careful! Some pictures are similar but not exactly the same. Use the calling card to cover the appropriate space on your board. The first player to cover all the spaces is the winner.



Halloween Concentration



To make:

Choose how many cards to include in the game, according to the age and ability of your child. We suggest that you start with 5 pairs of cards, and work up! You will find 9 cards on each of pages 2-5 - in other words a total of 36 cards to choose from. Print out two copies, and cut out.

To play:

Shuffle the cards and place face down on the table. Players take it in turns to turn over two cards, looking for a pair. If they find a pair, they take the cards and have another go. If they don't, they turn the cards face down again and try to memorise their position. When all the pairs have been matched up, the winner is the person who has found the most pairs.

Halloween Ghostie

To make:

Print out two copies of each of pages 2-5 and cut out all the cards. Put ONE copy of the following card aside.



To play:

You will need 3 or more players. Shuffle the remaining cards together well, and deal them out completely. Players look at their hands and put down on the table any pairs which they hold, being careful to keep the rest of their cards secret!

When all existing pairs are down on the table, the youngest player starts by turning to the player on their left and choosing (sight unseen) any card from their hand. If it forms a pair with an existing card, they put it straight down on the table. Play continues around the table, with everyone trying to be the first player to get rid of all their cards. One player will be left with the "Ghostie" card - he is the loser!
