

Origami Bunny (2)

This is a very simple origami bunny which teaches an important fold, so it is a good model for children to master. They can have fun adding features and a little "cotton tail".

This little bunny is perfect for Easter (we used the tail to stand him up and added a name tag to make a sweet place-holder - see photo overleaf). You could make a collection to stand on the mantelpiece, or use them for Easter cards too.



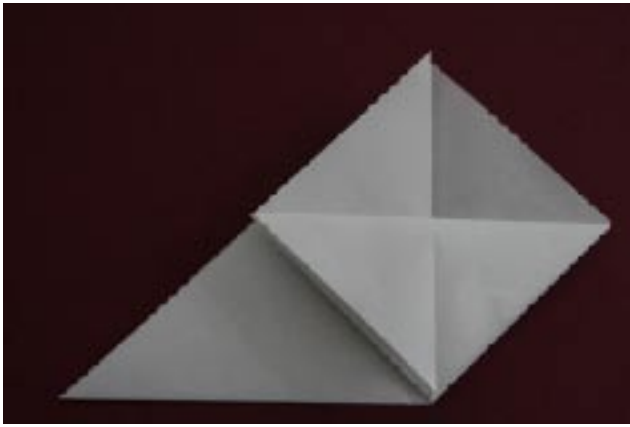
1. Fold your paper in half diagonally. 2. Fold in half again.



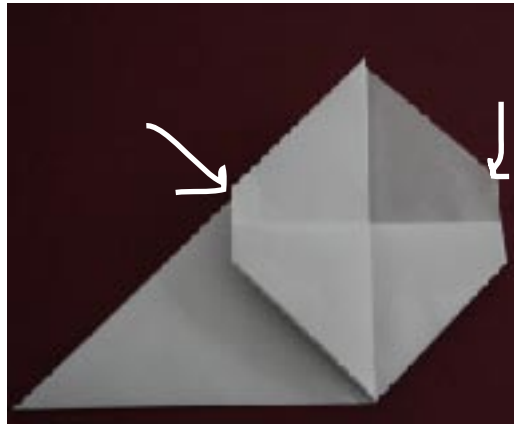
3. Lift the top flap up and open it out, bringing the points together at the top and squashing the sides out and flat ...

4. to form a square, as shown in the photo above.

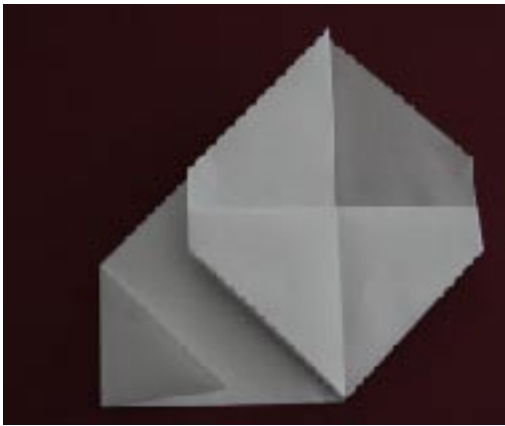

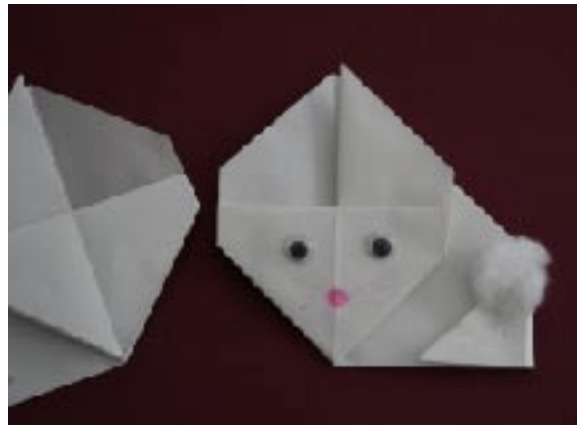
5. Fold the top flap of the square down, to begin to form the bunny's face...



6. and then tuck the corners behind.



7. Fold the left point in to form his hind legs. You can use this fold to stand your bunny up if you wish.
