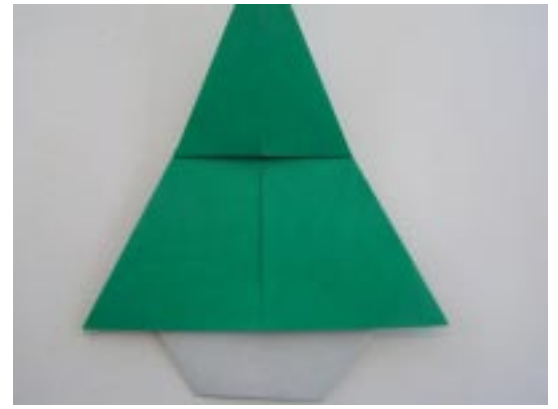
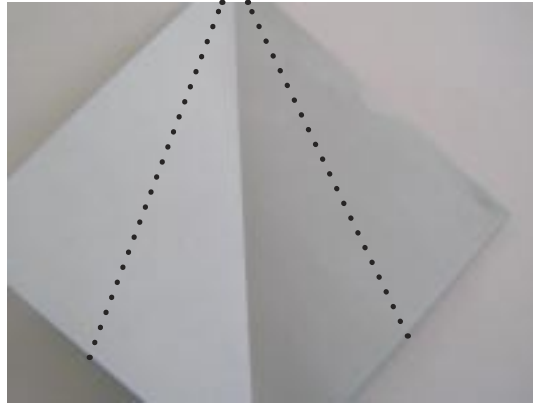


Origami Christmas Tree

This origami tree has a couple of slightly tricky folds, so younger children may need a little help. But once folded, they can have great fun decorating the tree with glitter, sequins, gold stars and other Christmas stickers.



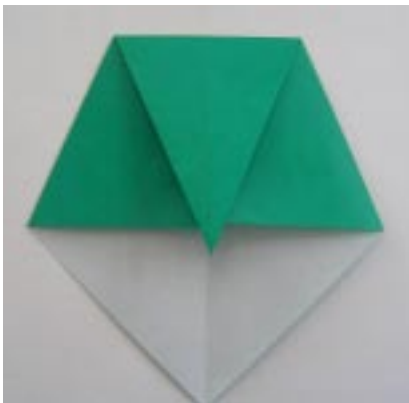
1. With the colored side down, fold your square on the diagonal to create.



2. Unfold. Fold the corners in on the dotted lines shown ..



2. so that your model looks like this. Make very sure that the green edges meet, as this will be the front of your tree!



4. Bring the top point down until it protrudes just a little past the green of the tree, as shown.

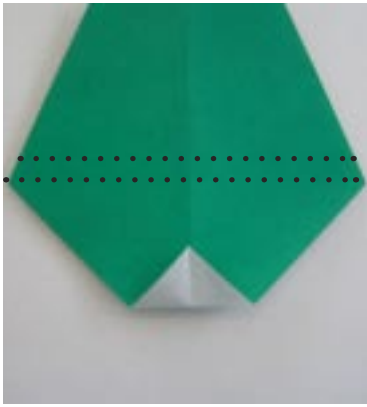


5. Now fold it back up again. Crease well.

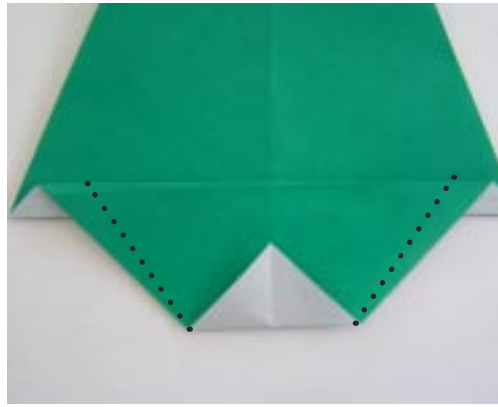


6. Flip over.

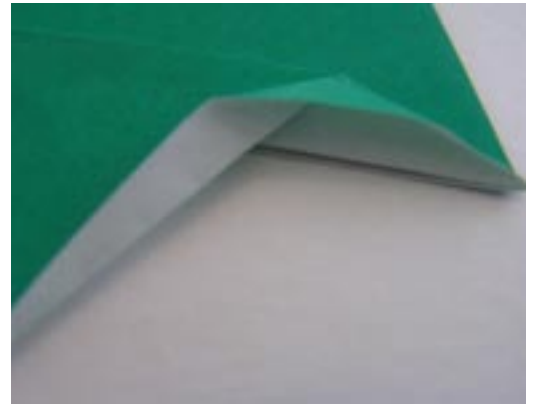

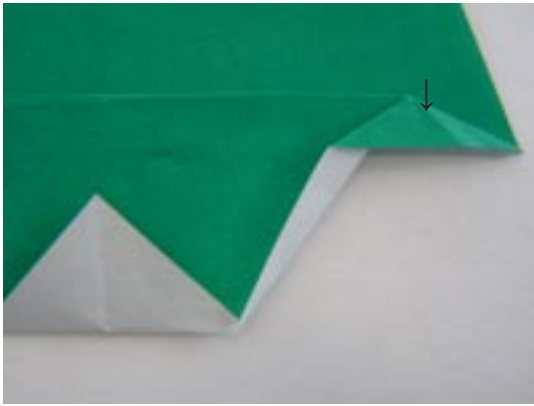
7. Turn the bottom point up into a small triangle, and then fold the bottom up and straight back down again, along the dotted lines shown.



8. Your model should look like this. The next fold is a little tricky and fiddly. You are going to turn the edges in along the dotted lines shown, and by doing so will



9. open up the area where it joint the base of the tree, and then fold it down into the triangle shown in the next photo.



10. Make the same move on the other side.



11. Narrow your tree slightly by folding in the edges as shown.

Flip over, and the Christmas Tree is ready for trimming!
