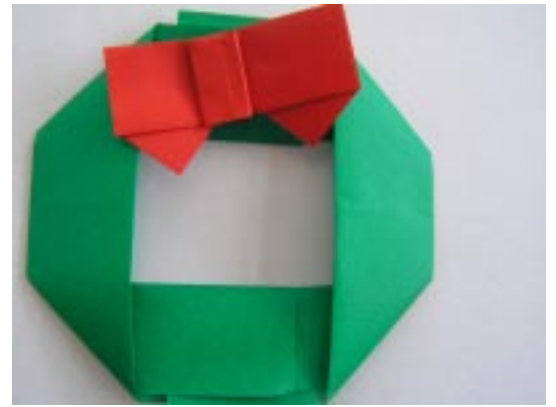


Origami Wreath

This cute little origami wreath can be decorated with stickers, glitter, pom poms, sequins, shapes cut out of shiny paper - whatever you have in your craft cupboard! Or keep it simple and add an origami bow as we have done.

(We used 6 inch square paper for the wreath and 3 inch square paper for the bow). You will need scissors - and possibly glue.



1. With your paper colored side down, fold your square horizontally and then vertically to crease as shown.



2. Cut carefully along one of the crease lines to make two rectangles.



3. You now need to fold each rectangle into thirds. You can measure for accuracy, or trust your eye, as we have done. In this photo we are folding the bottom third up ..



4. and in this photo we have folded the top third down.



5. Carefully fold the two ends down and in at a 45 degree angle, as shown in the photo above, creasing well.



6. Take the second rectangle and this time fold the two ends up and in, as shown.

7. Slide the two parts of the wreath together, pushing the ends of one inside the other. Use a glue stick to make the joins permanent if you wish.

6. Decorate the finished wreath - perhaps with a little origami bow, as we have done.
