

Origami Fish 2

This is a very simple fish model to make, although some of the folds feel a little strange to do! Make it in a bright color (use shimmery paper if you have some) and it will make a nice addition to your aquarium.

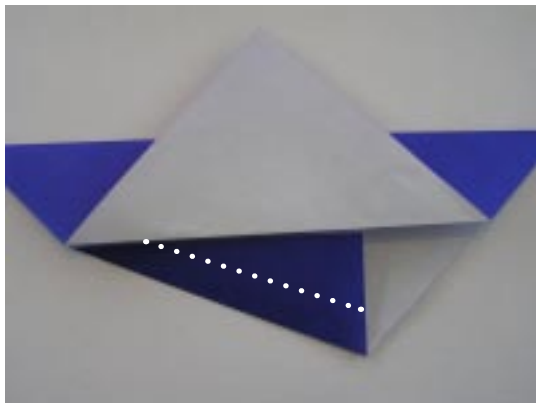
We have used a googly eye, but you could use a black marker to draw your eye, or stick on circles cut out of white and black paper for a similar effect.



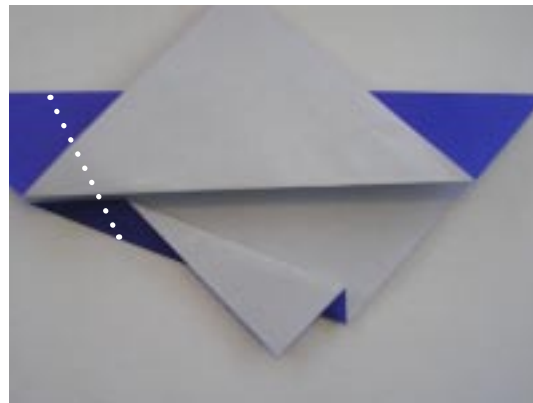
1. With the colored side down on the table, fold your square in half diagonally.



2. Place the triangle with the long side at the top. Now fold up the bottom point (the top layer only) so that it protrudes above the edge of the triangle, as shown.

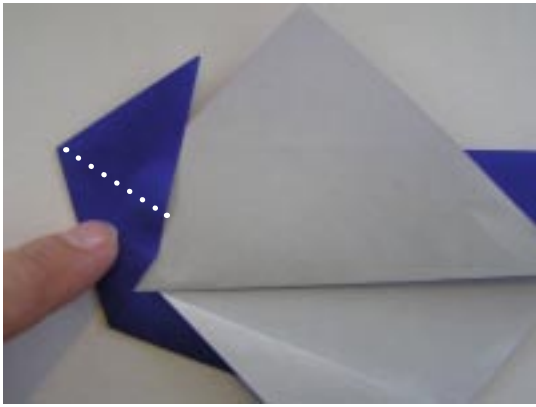


3. Fold up the left side of the triangle carefully, so that it lines up as shown. Fold the top portion back down immediately along the dotted line.

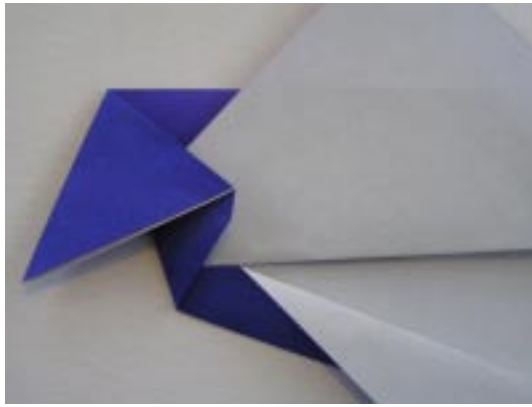


4. Your model should look like this. Now we are going to start to form the tail by turning the left corner in and up along the dotted line shown. Crease well.

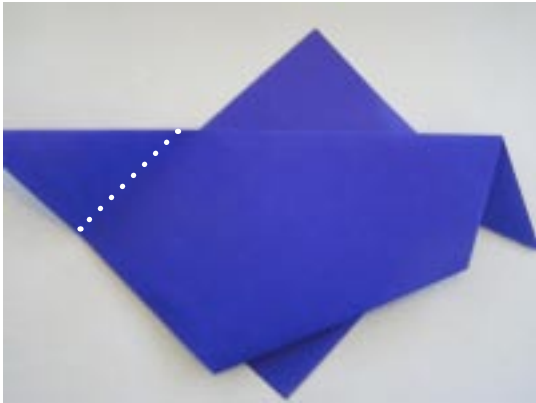

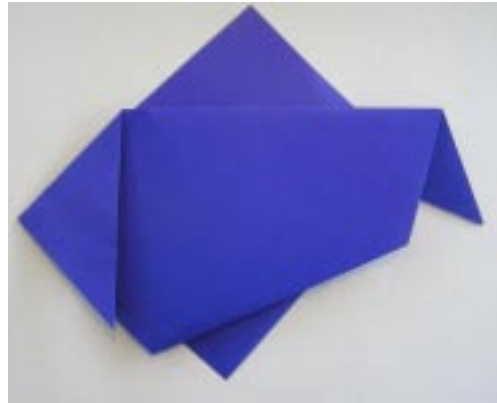
5. Your model should look like this. Turn the tail down again immediately on the dotted line, and crease well.



6. Make sure your tail section looks similar to the photo above!



7. Flip the model over and form the face by turning in the left corner along the dotted line. You might want to add a small dab of glue under the flap formed.



8. Now all you need to do is add your fish's eye, and decorate with pens, glitter, stickers and other embellishments if you wish.
