



# Origami Mummy


These look difficult, but in fact they are very straightforward - and very effective! Don't worry too much about the folds. Mummies look best if they are a bit messy! Stick these heads to a lollipop stick for a great little stick puppet or table decoration.



1 Start with a square of paper. Now begin to fold it back and forth, randomly, to form 4 folds..



2 Try to make some of the folds at an angle..




3 Here are 3 random folds.




4 Finished.



5 Fold the edges in towards the centre. This can be a little tricky as you will have to smooth the folds to keep the mummy's shape. Don't be too worried, though, as it all adds to the effect.



6 Now shape your head by folding in the bottom as shown.



7 Now fold in the top.



8 You can also pinch in the sides if you like (younger children may find this tricky).

## Origami Mummy - page 2



One of our mummies has a pair of googly eyes. The other has features drawn on with black felt tip.

A little bit of sticky tape and a couple of lolly sticks (popsicle sticks) turns our origami mummies into rather cute stick puppets!
