

Valentine Concentration Game



Instructions

Print the Concentration cards and cut them out. Shuffle, then deal them face down in front of you. Take it in turns to turn two cards over. If they match, you win those two cards. If not, try to remember what they are and where they are, then turn them face down again for the other player(s) to have a turn. When all pairs have been found, the winner is the player with the most cards.

If playing with younger children, use less sets of pairs and lay the cards in a structured pattern to make it easier to remember where they are. Encourage children to turn over the cards in a logical order, to help them remember!

Older children can make the game more difficult by using all the cards and spreading them in a random pattern on the table. They can also move around the table after every few goes just to make it harder to remember where the cards are!
