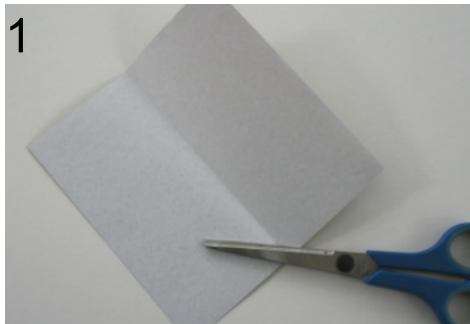
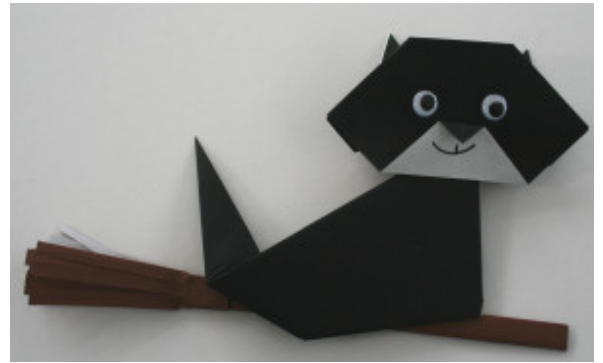
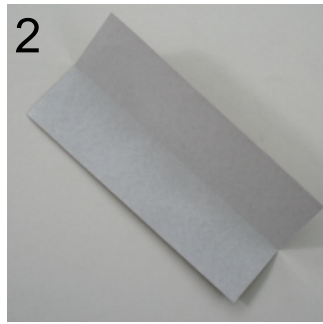


Origami Broomstick

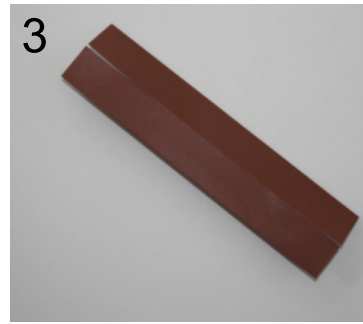
This miniature broomstick is not exactly true origami - although we are using origami paper and making some folds. Crease your folds well for this one, and use a glue stick for the joins. Please make sure that children are supervised when using scissors.



1
With coloured side down, fold your square in half as shown. Carefully cut along the crease.



2
Using one half only, fold in half and crease carefully. Open up.



3
Bring the sides in to the centre.



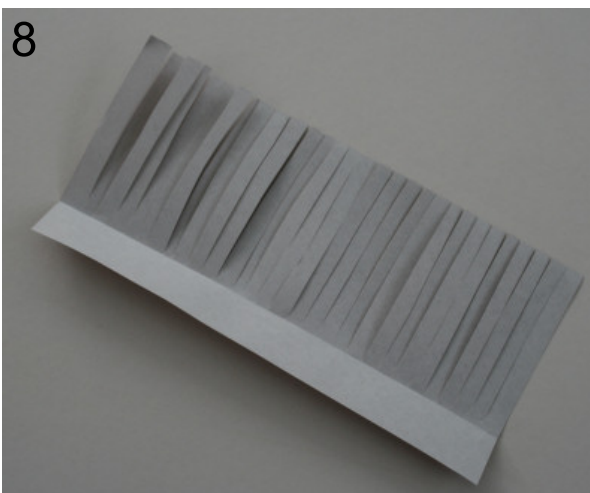
4
Fold the sides into the centre again, and crease well.



5
Run your glue stick over the top of the paper, the fold in half once more to stick together.



7
Take the second half of your paper, and turn in about 1cm along one edge. Crease, then unfold.



8
Use your scissors to cut the paper carefully as shown, making sure that you only cut up to the crease line.

Origami Broomstick - page 2



Glue all the way along the edge.



Place the stick on the glued portion, a little way in from the end. Fold the frilled paper over the stick and then continue to roll and fold until you have made your broomstick.
