

Nativity Finger Puppets or Models

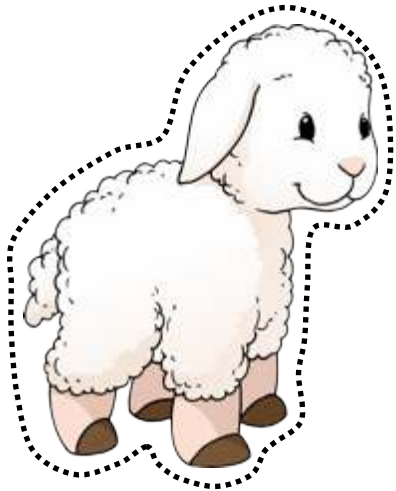
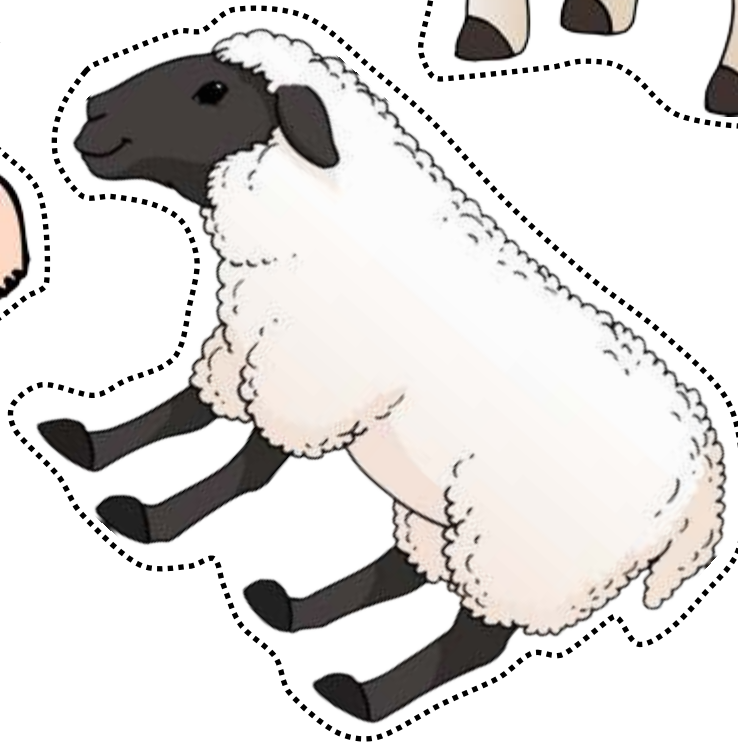
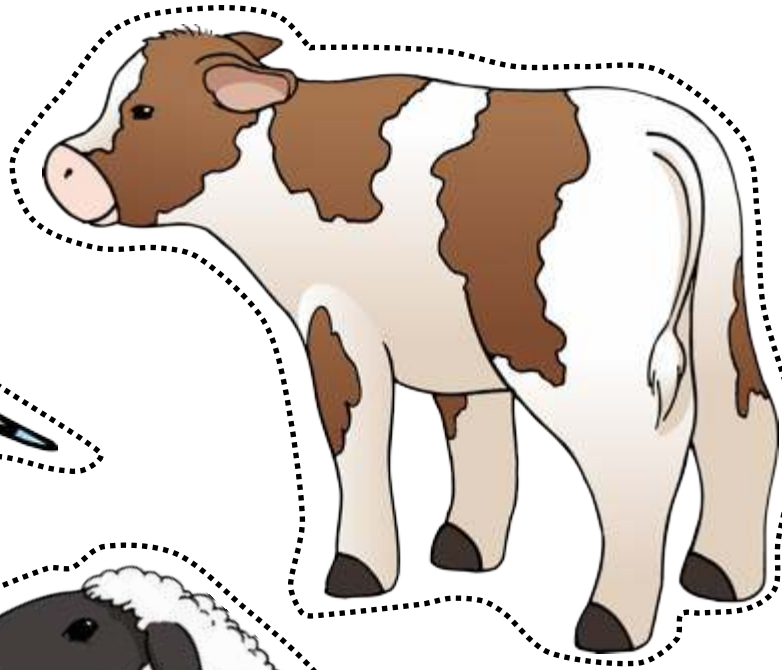


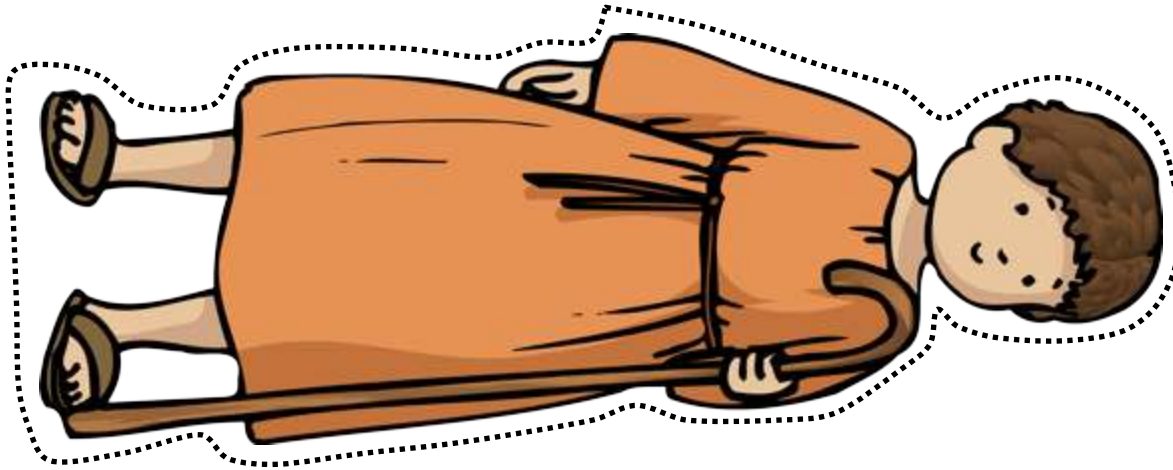
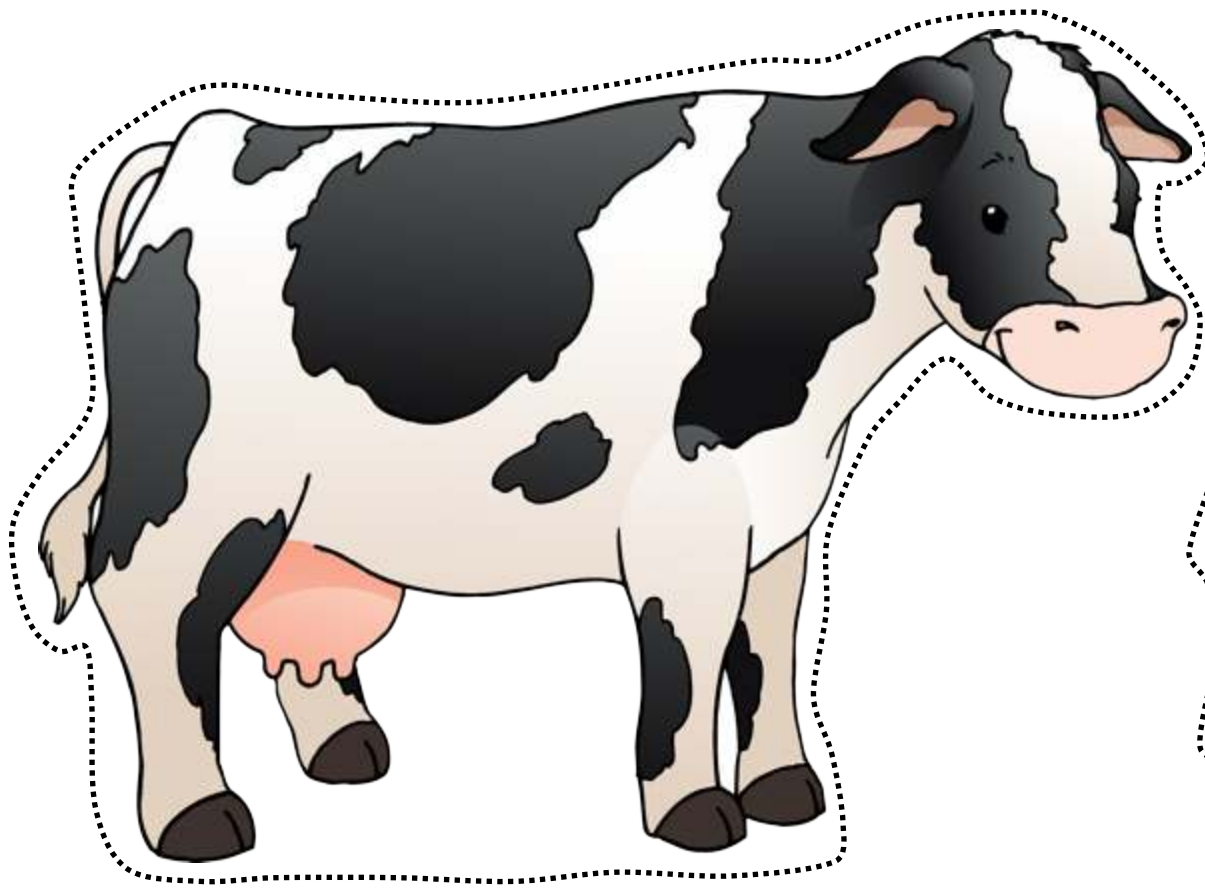
Cut out the models carefully. Older children can cut around the images while younger children can use the dotted lines.

To make finger puppets:
Cut short rectangles of card or scrap paper and roll into cylinders that fit your fingers easily. Use a little tape to attach to the back of the figures at a height which allows you to slip them on and use them comfortably.

To make models:
Cut rectangles of card or scrap paper and roll into cylinders about $\frac{3}{4}$ inch in diameter. Attach to the backs of the models about $\frac{1}{4}$ inch above the base. The models will now stand.









Stable:

To make the stable, cut out the image overleaf.

Fold the bottom edge of the stable up along the dotted line, then unfold again so that it stands at a near right angle to the stable.

Now cut a separate rectangle of card or paper roughly half the width of the stable and a little more than the height. Fold the card in half (like a greetings card) and attach to the back of the stable so that the fold is pointing upwards and the stable stands upright.
