

Origami Owl (2)

This owl is much more complicated to fold than our Origami Owl (1), and as such is more suitable for older children and origami folders with a little more experience!

You will need to start with the **origami bird base**. You will find instructions for the bird base in another download.



1. Start with the bird base.



2. Bring one of the top points down to the bottom point. Flip over, and do the same on the other side.



3. Fold the outside corners of the top flap in to meet the centre line, as shown.



4. Flip over, and do the same on the other side.



5. Lift the top flap slightly, and begin to ease the inside point outwards to the side as shown...



6. ... creasing it into position to form a wing, as in the photo above.

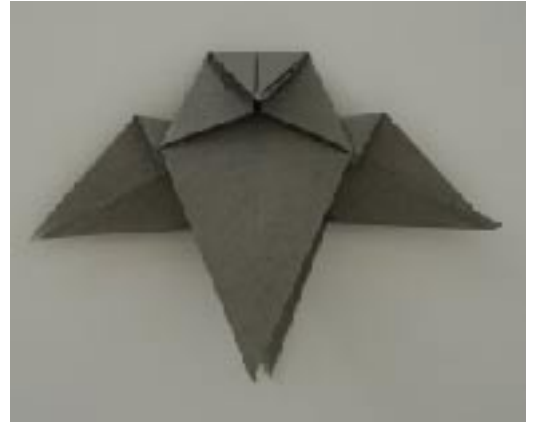
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7. Now we are doing the same thing on the other side...



8. ...to make the second wing.



9. Begin to form the face by folding the top point down, as shown.



10. Tuck the fold inside itself to give the owl its features and beak.



11. Add a flick at the bottom point, if you like, and your owl is done!
