

Owl Bookmark

You will need:

Large safety pin
Scraps of felt
Needle and thread

Instructions:

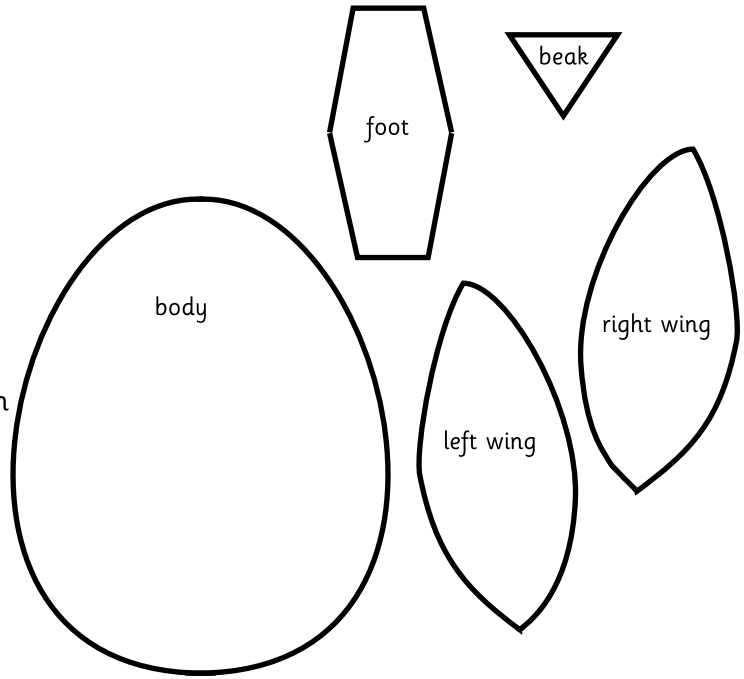
Cut 2 feet from orange felt. Slip the feet through the paperclip. Sew around the outside of each foot with one strand of embroidery thread. Sew along the bottom at the top of the paperclip so it stays in place.

Cut two bodies and two wings from felt. Sew the wings to one on the bodies.

Cut the beak from orange felt and sew on.

Embroider with back stitch two curved eyes.

Put the bodies together sandwiching the top of the feet inbetween and sew around the outside.

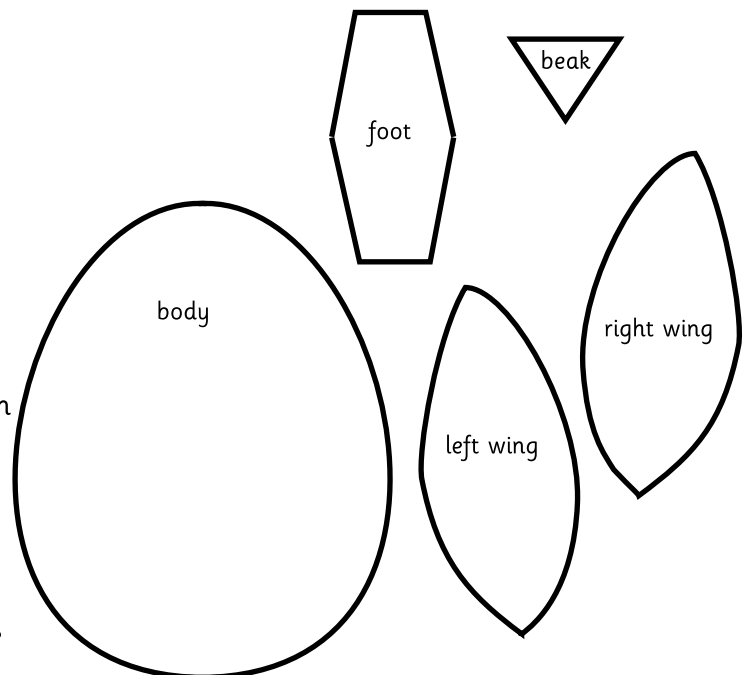
